The RNZAF is entering an extraordinary period of its life and during the next decade we will introduce into service more than thirty new or significantly upgraded aircraft across six different fleets.

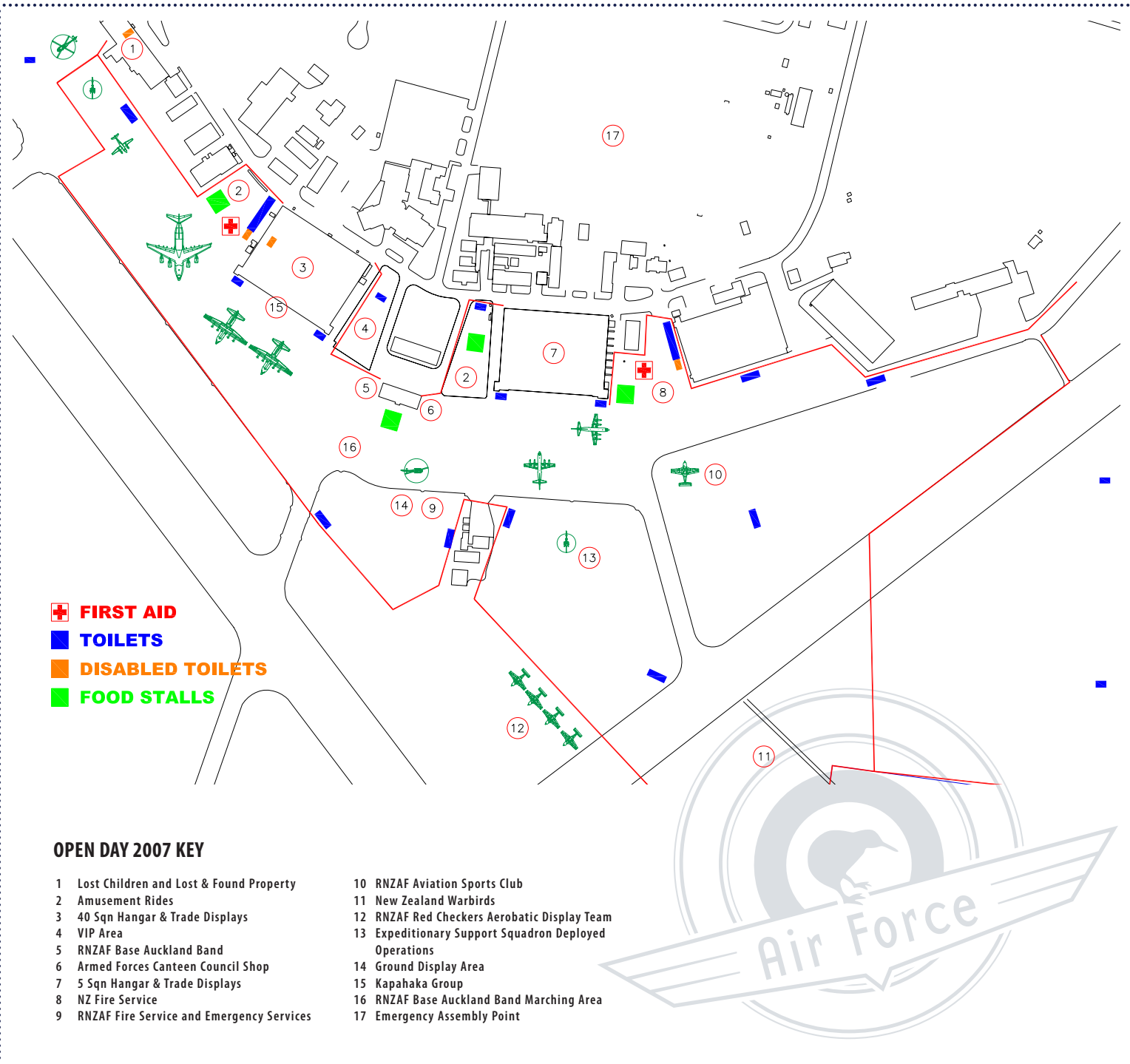
